These are the unapproved minutes from the Board of Education Special Meeting held on October 14, 2009.

09-137 CALL TO ORDER, PLEDGE TO THE FLAG AND ONE MINUTE OF SILENT MEDITATION

A Special Meeting of the Windsor Board of Education was held on Wednesday, October 14, 2009 in Room 17 at L. P. Wilson Community Center. Present were President Milo Peck, Doreen Richardson and Paul Panos (a Committee of Three), Frank Williams, Myron Senczikowska, Carol Christensen, Attorney Jeffrey Pingpank, Attorney Lorinda Coon, Attorney Vincent Oswecki, Parent of Student who is subject of hearing, and Ms. Rosa Colon (4 Barber Street). President Peck called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

09-138 PUPIL PERSONNEL MATTER

It is proposed that the Board of Education members go into Executive Session to hear Residency Case 10-01 before taking possible action in the public portion of the meeting.

At 5:10 p.m., President Peck adjourned the Board into Executive Session. Present during Executive Session were Board members Milo Peck, Doreen Richardson and Paul Panos (a Committee of Three).

Executive Session ended and the Board resumed the Special Meeting at 6:40 p.m.

Mr. Panos made a motion, seconded by Doreen Richardson, that the Board of Education finds that the family failed to sustain their burden of proof that the student who is the subject of this hearing is not a resident of Windsor, is not entitled to a free public education in the Windsor Public Schools pursuant with *Connecticut General statutes § 10-186*, and should be disenrolled.

The Board of Education authorizes the President to issue findings of fact and the decision of this committee to the respondent.

The motion was approved a by 3 – 0 vote.
